How It's Made

Our compost is a scientifically blended mix of pine bark, hardwood sawdust, cow manure, Marinova Organic seaweed extract, and coir peat. All of these certified organic materials are naturally composted for up to 12 weeks, with constant monitoring of core temperatures and nutrient levels to ensure the microbes are busy breaking down organic matter. When the windrows stabilise and enter the mesophyllic composting stage, we screen them with our state of the art screening facility to produce two distinct composted products..



Composted Premium Soil Conditioner

Using our newly commissioned trommel screen, HALS can now supply a premium, ultra fine compost with particle size 0-5mm, perfect for use as a soil conditioner. This compost is best for working into the soil to rapidly improve the organic matter content, water and nutrient holding capacity, and biological activity.



Fortified with Marinova seaweed extract, our compost is high in trace elements and plant growth hormones to promote healthy root and shoot activity.

Composted Mulch and Soil Conditioner

Compost with a mix of fine particles and slightly larger particles (0-11mm, 11-16mm available), is perfect for compost applications to the soil as a mulch. The large particles allow for faster water infiltration into the soil and break down over a longer amount of time. This will keep soil warm during winter and stimulate microbial activity, as well as preventing weed emergence.



Purchasing our Compost

Seagreens Premium Organic Compost is available as a soil conditioner (0-5mm) for very light mulching and soil incorporation, or as a composted mulch (blended 0-11mm). Special blends of particle sizes are available to cater to your individual production systems needs.

Bulk deliveries are available state-wide from 1-40m³, with bulka-bag (1.25m³) deliveries available on request. With our all terrain portable forklift, we can place a bulk-bag almost anywhere on your site.
